

Michigan Sales and Use Tax Certificate

This certificate is invalid unless all four sections are completed in full by the purchaser. The undersigned purchaser being fully informed concerning the Michigan Sales Tax Act and its rules & regulations certifies that he/she (it) is legally entitled to exemption from such taxes on the purchase of tangible personal property and selected services made under this certificate and certifies that this claim is based upon the purchaser's proposed use of the items or services, or the status of the purchaser.
